



Measure of Registrar No. 1/2021 Transportation of fish by vehicles of the FFPW USB

1. When transporting fish over a distance of more than 50 km and within 8 hours (TYPE 1), the driver / guide must carry a duly completed **Vehicle register for animal transport**. The Vehicle register is kept by the carrier for all transports of animals for vehicles transporting animals over a distance of more than 50 km. If the documentation no longer appears in the folder marked "**Transport of fish**" located in the passenger compartment of the respective vehicle, it is necessary to pick it up from the FFPW USB dispatcher before each journey and return it after the journey. The carrier shall submit it to the inspection authorities on request and keep the completed forms for a period of 3 years.
2. When transporting the fish at a distance of more than 50 km and journey time exceeds 8 hours, the transported animals must be accompanied by a person with a certificate of competence for drivers and guides in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2 of Council Regulation (EC) No.1/2005.
3. The Vehicle mark, the Permit of the carrier TYPE 2 and the Certificate of approval of means of transport is necessary to pick up at the dispatcher of FFPW USB before each journey and return back after the end of journey (if the documentation does not appear in the folder marked "Fish transport" located in the passenger compartment of the respective vehicle).
4. When planning the transportation of fish abroad or for longer than 8 hours it is necessary to contact the relevant State Veterinary Administration and follow the current regulations that are set for that transport. It is also necessary to record this journey in the Vehicle register, which is situated in the closeable box in each vehicle. Every driver must deliver the Veterinary Certificate about animal transportation to the dispatcher after the drivers return from the journey.
5. After each use of transport boxes for fish, it is necessary to clean them properly, disinfect and dry them. In case of disinfection and handling of the transport box, contact the dispatcher or the head of the operational workplaces where the transport boxes are located (EFCF and GFC). It is also necessary to clean the loading area of the vehicle. These operations are recorded in a workbook in the vehicle. The driver who returns the vehicle is responsible for these operations. If necessary, the driver will secure the oxygen bottles in advance of departure. The driver who borrows the vehicle is responsible for this.
6. The driver / guide of each individual journey is responsible for fulfilling all the conditions imposed by the Council Regulation (EC) No.1/2005, the Act No.246/1992 Coll. On the protection of animals against cruelty, as amended, and Regulation No. 4/2009 Coll. On the protection of animals during transport.
