Addendum No. 1 to Dean's Measure No. 19/2024 and No. 6/2025 Regarding the Rules for the 1st and 2nd Round of the Admission Procedure and Conditions for the Admission to Study in the Academic Year 2025/2026

Delivery of documents in the admissions process

The delivery of documents within the framework of the above-mentioned admission procedures is governed by Section 69a of the amended Act No. 111/1998 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and the provisions of Article 25, Paragraph 7 of the Statute of the University of South Bohemia of 31 January 2025. All documents, with the exception of those that cannot be sent otherwise due to the nature of the matter, will be sent to the participants of the admission procedure via the electronic information system of the University (hereinafter referred to as IS/STAG), regardless of the option chosen by the applicant in the electronic application of the University of South Bohemia in České Budějovice. Pursuant to Section 69a(3), the Faculty is not obliged to deliver these documents via a public data network to a data mailbox.

According to Section 69a, subsection 4, the date of delivery of a document via IS/STAG shall be the date on which the applicant logs in to IS/STAG after the document has been made available in IS/STAG. If he/she does not log in within 10 days from the date on which the document was made available to him/her in IS STAG, the document shall be deemed to have been delivered on the last day of that period.
