Dean's Measure No. 3/2026

Extraordinary Scholarships to Support First-Year Students Enrolled in Full-Time Bachelor's Degree Programmes

1. The purpose of this measure is to support first-year students enrolled in full-time bachelor's degree programmes at FFPW USB, with the aim of:
 - facilitating the transition from the secondary education system to the higher education system, including the financial demands associated with university studies.
 - motivating students with strong academic potential to enrol at FFPW USB.
 - reducing the rate of study failure in the first years of bachelor's degree programmes.
2. Entitlement to an extraordinary scholarship under this measure is limited exclusively to students enrolled in full-time bachelor's degree programmes who are enrolled in studies at FFPW USB for the first time and who, at the time of enrolment at FFPW USB, have not exceeded three years since the completion of full secondary education.
3. All students of FFPW USB pursuant to paragraph 2 of this measure who enrol in their studies within the regular enrolment period in accordance with the relevant academic year schedule and who remain students of FFPW USB as of November, 1 shall be granted ex officio a one-off financial support of CZK 5,000 pursuant to Section 91(2)(e) of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Other Acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the Higher Education Act).
4. All students pursuant to paragraph 2 of this measure who complete the faculty adaptation course and the matriculation ceremony of FFPW USB in the given academic year and who, as of November, 1 of the given year, record no absences in compulsory FFPW USB courses shall be granted ex officio a one-off financial support of CZK 5,000 pursuant to Section 91(2)(e) of the Higher Education Act.
5. Students pursuant to paragraph 2 of this measure with strong academic performance from secondary school who meet the criteria set out in the table below shall, within 90 days of enrolment at FFPW USB, provided that they remain students, be granted ex officio a one-off extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Section 91(2)(e) of the Higher Education Act, according to the relevant category to which they belong:

* - The grade point average is calculated from the final report cards of the last four years of secondary school studies.

6. Secondary school results must be documented at the faculty study office by officially certified copies of the relevant report cards.
7. All students pursuant to paragraph 2 of this measure who, after the first semester of study and by the deadline set out in the FROV JU academic year schedule, obtain at least 20 credits from compulsory and compulsory elective courses of their study plan shall be granted ex officio a one-off extraordinary scholarship in the amount of CZK 8,000 pursuant to Section 91(2)(e) of the Higher Education Act.
8. This measure shall enter into force on the date of its approval by the Dean's Board of FFPW USB and shall become effective as of the 2026/2027 academic year. Upon the effectiveness of this measure, Dean's Measure No. 1/2019 shall be repealed.
